Introduction

This Annual Report covers the period from 1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020, a year which will be remembered in history for the disruption brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic which brought most things, including sports, to a forced break.

Nevertheless, for Siggiewi Rowing Club (SRC), 2020 will also be remembered as the year when it was enrolled with Office of the Commissioner for Voluntary Organisations and thus formally attaining the status of a VO as well as completing most of the formality to be enlisted in the register of Sports Organisations with SportMalta.

This year also saw new athletes registering with Siggiewi Rowing Club and a change in the Club administration as detailed below.

Dr Michelle Vella Wood acted as SRC President for the period Jan-August and, following the AGM on the 2nd September 2020 she took the new role of Secretary, following the notice given by **Mr Jesmond Grech** that he could no longer occupy this role following the AGM. Dr Vella Wood and **Mr Grech** were instrumental in keeping the Club alive in the very difficult early months of 2020 when Malta was at a standstill.

Professor Joseph N. Grima was elected as President on the AGM of the 2nd September 2020 who gave a new impetus to the Club, first and foremost by finalizing all the formalities to register SRC as a VO and with SportMalta, obtain the necessary clearance to Coach young athletes, etc. Together with other members of the Committee, he also started actively looking for new athletes to join the Club.

Ms Gillian Farrugia Pace, Capt. Andre` Buhagiar and **Dr Danica Spiteri Bonello** acted as Treasurer, Physical Trainer and PRO respectively and, apart from performing the work associated with these roles, supported the Committee with their extensive expertise and very useful advice.

The Board met regularly and frequently throughout the year, particularly in the last months of the year with electronic meeting being organized every few days when the Club was in the final stages of registering as a VO and with SportMalta. All members contributed to the discussion.

Projects / Activities during the year

Due to its unique nature, activities during 2020 were limited and all activities that the Club usually organizes in spring and summer had to be cancelled.

The only competition that Club athletes participated in was the World Rowing Indoor Championships that were held in Paris between the 7th and 8th February 2020. In this Championship athletes Michelle Vella Wood (Club President at the time, now Secretary) and Claire Sammut (who is now officially registered with SRC) competed in the 2000m and 500m LW.

The Malta National Indoor Rowing Championships that are normally held in November 2020 were unfortunately not held.

Nevertheless, the Club still managed to organize a very successful Indoor Rowing Event on the 29th December 2020, with the help of Siggiewi Local Council, which brought the SRC community of friends together, including a good number of new athletes and parathletes who registered with the Club, and collected money for the Siggiewi Dar tal-Providenza (sent directly to Dar tal-Providenza). This event was featured on TVM.

In addition, 2020 had an elective AGM which saw a change in Committee composition as noted above. The AGM also appointed Jesmond Grech M.Ed.(Melit.) as an Honorary President in recognition of his sterling work and constant support.

Financial Report

SRC is still at its beginning and most of its income comes from members' donations. Given that we were not registered as a VO prior to Sept, no fund-raising events were organised and no membership fees were collected. The income generated from donations from rower members was used to pay for the registration expenses and to purchase T-shirts (co-sponsored by EuroSport) to give athletes a corporate identity (see above).

Conclusion

Now that the Club is formally registered as a VO, the Club aspires to expand by extending its membership, including through Ordinary membership and expand in its rowing activities. 2021 will mark the 5th anniversary of the setting up of the Club and its affiliation with Malta Rowing Association (Għaqda Regatta Nazzjonali u Qdif Iehor) and hence the Club should become entitled to full membership of the Association with the right to participate in the National Regattas (31st March and 8th September Regattas). It is hoped that this will see the Club starting to compete at such events.

The Club also aspires to start organizing Indoor Rowing Classes, aimed at a diverse range of athletes, from recreational to semi-professional. The Club will continue to give priority to the development of pararowing.

The Club thanks all those who have supported the Club to enable the dreams of the Siggiewi affiliated rowers become a reality.
